# 1) Police Facility update

The Chief advised that construction is on budget and on schedule. He advised that the drywall is wrapping up and painting has begun, lockers have been installed, and plumbing and electrical are well under way and hope to be completed by mid-August.

The Chief advised that the furniture RFP has closed with three bidders and have been going through the proposals to award contract.

#### 2) Canine Unit

The Chief advised that donations are still coming in – Rotary \$4,000, Tim Panchyshyn \$1,000.

The Chief advised he was speaking with Tim today and was advised that he and volunteer Abby Bolton are interested in putting on a dinner and dance in the fall and making it an annual event with the proceeds going to the Canine Unit fund.

#### 3) <u>Criminal Investigations/Drug Unit</u>

The Chief advised that the Unit is busy and just completed a joint investigation with Hanover and Owen Sound re the sale of illicit cannabis dispensaries.

## 4) Facility Cleaning

The Chief advised he has advised Weiler's of the Board's motion to retain their services for the new facility and have given the current custodian ample notice.

#### 5) Opioid Strategy

The Chief advised there will be public presentations in the fall of 2019 to bring awareness and education re opioids to municipalities in Grey and Bruce which will include Police, Paramedics and Public Health.
